Snoozing in the shade of a paperbark on the edge of the billabong is a great way to spend the afternoon, sections of the dry river bed are a rock hounds heaven, (gold panning in the creeks, absolutely) birdlife abounds, local wild-life inquisitive and the scenery is spectacular.
